










Symbol	Italian Term	Definition
<i>pp</i>	Pianissimo	Very soft
<i>p</i>	Piano	Soft
<i>mp</i>	Mezzo Piano	Medium soft
<i>mf</i>	Mezzo Forte	Medium loud
<i>f</i>	Forte	Loud
<i>ff</i>	Fortissimo	Very Loud

Symbol	Italian Term	Definition
	Accent	Note is emphasized, performed louder
	Tenuto	Hold note for its full value
	Staccato	Short, detached
	Crescendo	Gradually get louder
	Decrescendo	Gradually get softer
	Fermata	Pause on the note, watch conductor for release
	Coda	The "tail", ending of a piece of music
	Segno	Repeat music from the sign
	Glissando	Sliding from one note to another
