## The True Story of the Von Trapps

In August 1934, Adolf Hitler became the dictator of Germany. A dictator is a leader who has total control and power of a country. They often come to power by force. The era when Nazi Germany was in power is called the Third Reich. The Third Reich lasted from 1933 to 1945. It ended when Germany lost World War II.

Like most countries, Austria struggled during the 1930s. The worldwide depression effected the country economically, politically, and socially.

Austria's chancellor at the time was Engelbert Trapp Family Singers | Public Domain Dollfuss. Dollfuss was leading Austria towards dictatorship, but he did not want to join Nazi Germany. The Nazis responded by assassinating him in 1934. The Nazis attempted to overthrow the Austrian government, but failed.



In 1938, the Nazis invaded Austria and made Austria part of Nazi Germany. This is called an annexation and the event was known as the Anschluss (pronounced ahn-shluss). Soon after, the Nazis began drafting men to fight for the Third Reich's army. Drafts forced men to join the military or risk being arrested.

The Von Trapps in *The Sound of Music* lived in Austria during these events. The children's names were Rupert, Agathe, Maria, Werner, Hedwig, Johanna and Martina. Unlike most Austrian people at the time, Captain Von Trapp did not agree with the Anschluss. In The Sound of Music, the captain and Maria return from their honeymoon. The captain learns that he has been drafted to serve in the Third Reich's navy. He decides it is best for them to leave his beloved Austria.

At the end of the movie, the family sings, "So Long, Farewell" at a festival. Immediately after, instead of the captain being forced into the navy, the family runs away. The Von Trapps hide in the abbey and travel across the border into Switzerland. Switzerland was a neutral country throughout the war, which means they had no side. In real life, the family did perform at a festival and became popular for their singing. Like the movie, the captain did not agree with the Anschluss. The family originally traveled to Italy, not Switzerland.

In the 1940s, the Von Trapp family moved to Vermont in the United States. The Trapp Family Singers were popular in the United States. The Von Trapps lived in America for the rest of their lives. Everyone ultimately became American citizens except the captain. He died in 1947 at the age of 67. Maria died in 1987 at the age of 82. Maria has published a memoir called The Story of the Trapp Family Singers.
